DESIGN FOR SHIRT-STUDS.

Specification forming part of Design No. **S,756**, dated October 26, 1875; application filed September 15, 1875.
[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, LEONARD S. BEALS, of Astoria, in the county of Queens and State of New York, have originated and designed a Pattern for Shirt-Studs, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, making part of this specification, in which drawing—

Figure 1 represents a plan or top view. Fig. 2 is a side elevation.

Similar letters indicate corresponding parts.

My design for shirt-studs consists in a circular cup provided with a flat polished rim, and contains a globular coral, fitting closely in said cup.

In the drawing, the letter A designates my

shirt-stud, which is composed of a circular cup, *a*, with a flat rim, *b*, and of a spiral shank, *c*, supporting said cup. In the cup is secured a globular coral, *d*, which fits the interior of the cup.

What I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design for a shirt-stud, composed of a cup, *a*, which is provided with a flat rim, *b*, and which contains a globular coral, *d*, as shown and described.
