DESIGN FOR SHIRT-STUDS.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8,757, dated October 26, 1875; application filed September 15, 1875 [Term of Patent 3½ years.]

CASE B.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, LEONARD S. BEALS, of Astoria, in the county of Queens and State of New York, have originated and designed a new Pattern for Shirt-Studs, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, making part of this specification, in which drawing-

Figure 1 represents a plan or top view.

Fig. 2 is a side elevation.

Similar letters indicate corresponding parts. This design for shirt-stud consists in an oblong rectangular cup, with a flat rim and rounded corners, in combination with a cylindrical coral fitting said cup.

In the drawing, the letter A designates a

shirt-stud, which is composed of an oblong eup, a, and a spiral shauk, b. Said eup is provided with a flat rim, c, the corners of which are rounded, and in the cup is placed a cylindrical coral, d.

What I claim as new, and desire to secure

by Letters Patent, is-

The design for a shirt-stud, composed of an oblong rectangular cup, a, having a flat rim with rounded corners, and containing a cylindrical coral, d, as shown and described.
