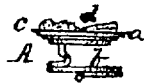

DESIGN FOR SHIRT-STUDS.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,758**, dated October 26, 1875; application filed September 15, 1875.
[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

CASE C.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, LEONARD S. BEALS, of Astoria, in the county of Queens and State of New York, have originated and designed a new Pattern for Shirt-Studs, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, making part of this specification, in which drawing—

Figure 1 represents a plan or top view. Fig. 2 is a side view.

Similar letters indicate corresponding parts.

This design for shirt-studs consists in an elliptical cup with a flat rim, in combination with a cameo representing the figure of a human head, and fitting said cup.

In the drawing, the letter A designates my

shirt-stud, which is composed of an elliptical cup, *a*, supported by a spiral shank, *b*. Said cup is provided with a flat rim, *c*, and it contains a cameo, *d*, representing the figure of a human head.

What I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design for shirt-stud, composed of an elliptical cup, *a*, having a flat rim, *c*, and containing a cameo, *d*, representing the figure of a human head, as shown and described.
