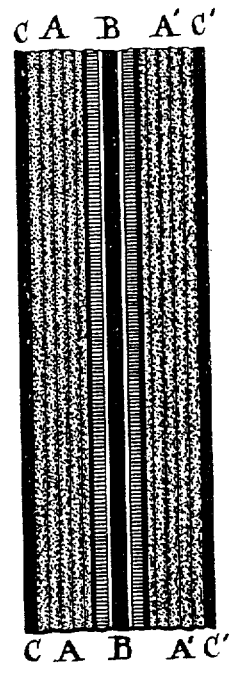

## DESIGN FOR BOOT AND SHOE WEBBING.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,760**, dated October 26, 1875; application filed August 2, 1875.  
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, JAMES A. GREENE, of the town of North Kingstown, in the county of Washington and State of Rhode Island, have invented a new and useful Design for Boot and Shoe Webbing; and I do hereby declare the following specification, taken in connection with the drawings making a part of the same, is a full, clear, and exact description thereof.

Figure 1 of the accompanying drawing represents a section of boot-webbing.

A and A' represent portions of the body of the webbing or stripes of mixed colors. B represents a central portion, composed of a number of stripes of various colors, of any width that may be selected. C and C' represent the edges or border, which may be of any width or color.

I have made the warp of red, yellow, and

purple, and the filling of green; but I do not consider the colors selected to be an essential element of my design.

I am aware that boot and shoe webbing with a mixed colored stripe on either side of a central portion is not new with two colors, and I do not claim it.

The distinctive character of my design is found in the mixed or mottled stripe of four colors on either side of a central portion.

What I claim as my invention is—

A design for boot and shoe webbing, in which there is a mixed or mottled colored stripe on either side of the central portion of four colors.
