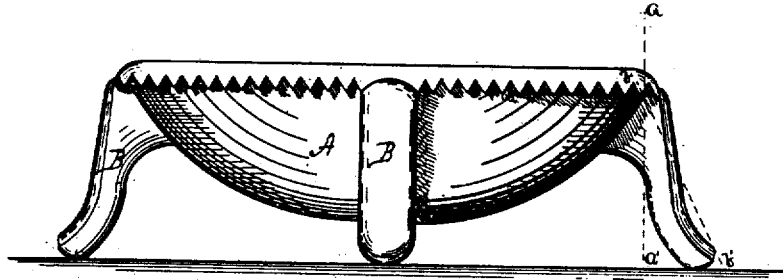

HENRY FRANZ, OF PITTSBURG, PENNSYLVANIA.

DESIGN FOR GLASSWARE.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8,764, dated November 2, 1875; application filed October 18, 1875.
[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, HENRY FRANZ, of Pittsburg, in the county of Allegheny and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new and Improved Design for Glassware; and I do hereby declare the following to be a full, clear, and exact description thereof, reference being had to the accompanying drawing illustrating my design as applied to a nappy.

My design is intended to be applied to footed hollow glassware; and consists in attaching the foot to the article so that its line of projection shall be in or near a vertical plane touching the greatest diameter on a line drawn between any two feet of the article, whereby a distinct and characteristic configuration is obtained.

In the drawing, A represents the nappy, B the foot thereof, the dotted line *a a'* the ver-

tical plane touching the side of the article at its greatest diameter, and *b a'* and *b b'* the lines of continuation and of projection, which will give the specified effects.

What I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design for hollow glass articles having feet, produced by attaching the feet to the article so that the line of projection shall be in or near a vertical plane touching the greatest diameter on a line drawn between any two feet, substantially as described.
