DESIGN FOR SATCHEL-HANDLE TIP.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8,776, dated November 9, 1875; application filed June 21, 1875. [Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, GEORGE O. MONROE, of Newark, in the county of Essex and State of New Jersey, have invented or produced a Design for Satchel-Handle Tips, of which the following is a description:

This tip is nearly circular, and slightly tapering, and is made with a loop at the lower

The present design relates to the ornamental shape and configuration of the edges of

the sheet-metal tip.

In the drawing I have shown a perspective

view of the tip for satchel-handles.

The edges \hat{a} a are scalloped or serrated, and the end portions of the tip are made as com-

pound or ogee curves that are ornamental, and serve to improve the general appearance of the tip. The tip has a contraction or neck at e between the socket portion for the handle and the loop f at the end of the tip.

I claim-

The design of the ornamental shape and configuration of satchel-handle tip, substantially as described and represented.
