

DESIGN FOR BOXES.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8,800, dated November 23, 1875; application filed October 13, 1875.

[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JOSEPH H. ENGLAND, of the city of Baltimore and State of Maryland, have invented a Design for a Box, of which the following is a specification:

which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is represented in the accompanying drawing, to which reference is made. Figure 1 showing a top, and Fig. 2 a side, view of the design.

The box, as viewed from the top and bottom, is shaped like an oyster, and is flat, having perpendicular sides, as shown in Fig. 2. The lid preferably used is one adapted to slip

over the box, as shown; but other kinds of lid may be employed without change in the character of this design. The hole placed centrally of the box is that known as the venthole used in the packing of oysters, for which use the box is intended.

I claim as my invention-

A design for a box having the oyster-like shape, substantially as herein specified.
