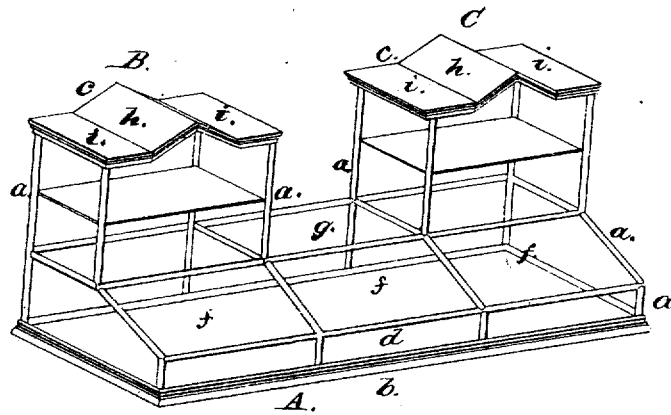

DESIGN FOR SHOW-CASES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,813**, dated November 30, 1875; application filed July 22, 1875.
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

CASE A.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, JOSEPH LEHNBEUTER and CASPAR CLAES, both of St. Louis, St. Louis county, State of Missouri, have invented a certain Design for Show-Cases, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, making part of this specification:

The nature of our design is fully represented in the accompanying drawing, to which reference is made.

The case consists of three main parts, A, B and C. The part A extends the whole length and breadth (or depth) of the case; and the parts B and C extend upward from the ends of part A.

The frame-bars throughout the case are shown at *a*, said bars serving for the support of the glass panes, forming the walls of the case. The base or bottom is shown at *b*, and the tops of the turrets B C are shown at C. These tops and the bottom may be formed of any suitable material, as transparency in them is not necessary.

The turrets B C do not extend to the front

wall *d* of the case, but in front of said turret and extending the whole length of portion A, are inclined planes *fff*. In front of these inclines *fff* is the vertical wall *d*, which extends the whole length of

Between the turrets B C is a flat surface upon which articles for sale may be laid. The tops of the turrets B C are made to project at the middle, and running the whole depth of the turrets, the appearance of an angular roof, *h*, and at each side of the part *h* is a horizontal part, *i*, on which articles may be stored for show.

What we claim as our invention is—

The design for a show-case, consisting of a lower portion A, provided with outwardly-inclined planes *fff* extending its whole length, turrets B C at each end, and the central horizontal portion *g* between said turrets, substantially as shown and described.
