

DESIGN FOR SHOW-CASES.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8,815, dated November 30, 1875; application filed July 22, 1875. [Term of Patent 7 years.]

CASE C.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, Joseph Lehnbeuter and Caspar Claes, both of St. Louis, St. Louis county, State of Missouri, have originated a new Design for Show-Cases, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying drawing making part of this specification:

The nature of our design is fully represented in the accompanying drawing, to which reference is made.

The case consists of a lower portion, A, extending the whole length of the case, and two elevated portions, B and C, over the ends of part A. The portions B and C extend from the back of the case some distance forward, but not to the front, so as to make distinct curved faces from the front of the part A. The outwardly-convex face of part B, and that of C, are shown at b, and the face in

front of part A, extending the whole length of the case, is shown at a. The middle part c of the top of A, between the elevated portions B and C, is flat, and serves as a counter in handling articles for sale. The bars of the frame, in which the panes are supported, are shown at d. e is the bottom of the case.

What we claim herein as our invention is— The design for a show-case, consisting of lower portion A, provided with outwardlyconvex front a, extending its whole length, elevated rear portions B C, at each end provided with outwardly-convex fronts b b, and the central horizontal top between said elevated rear portions, substantially as shown and described.
