## DESIGN FOR STOCKING-LEGS.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8,822, dated December 7, 1875; application filed October 14, 1875.

[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, MARTIN LANDENBER-GER, Jr., of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented a Design for the Leg of a Stocking, of which the following is a specification:

The accompanying drawing illustrates my design for the embroidered leg of a stocking, A, Figure 1, showing part of the leg with the embroidered stripe a, which may be on one or both sides of the said leg, Fig. 2 being an enlarged view of the embroidering-stitch, the character of which is too clearly illustrated to need description.

It is immaterial what the width, extent, or

form of the stripe may be, providing it consists of stitches of the ornamental character shown in Fig. 2.

I claim-

The design for the leg of a stocking ornamented with stitches of the character illustrated and described.
