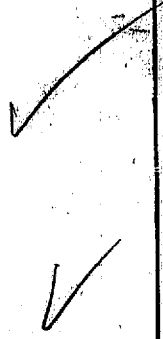

DESIGN FOR TOY BALLOON.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8,847, dated December 14, 1875; application filed November 24, 1875.
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, HUGH S. KERR, of the city and county of Philadelphia, and State of Pennsylvania, have originated and designed a Design for Toy Balloon, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, making part of this specification.

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying drawing, to which reference is made.

A represents the body of the toy balloon, in

the form of a winged human figure, representing the act of flying, thus producing an attractive and agreeable toy.

What I claim as my invention is—

The toy balloon in the form of a winged human figure, substantially as described, and shown in the accompanying illustration.
