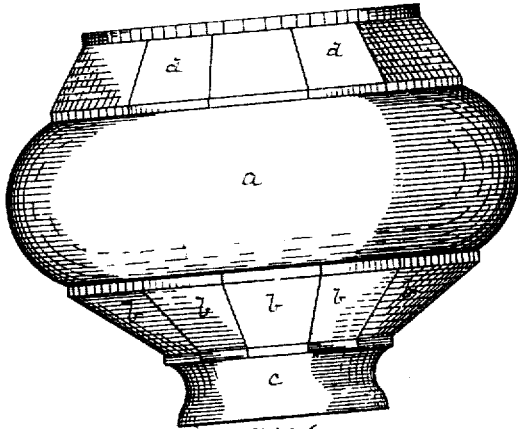

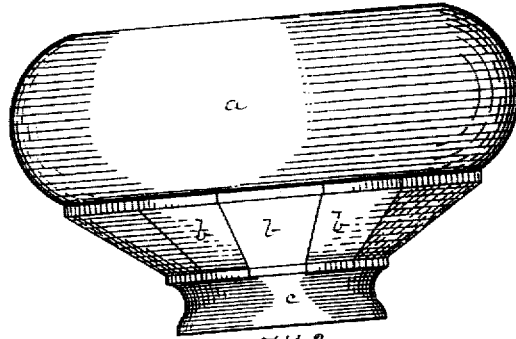

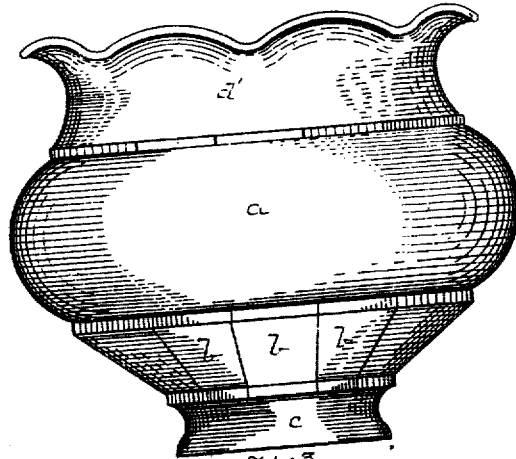

DESIGN FOR GLASS SHADES.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8,866, dated December 28, 1875; application filed December 18, 1875.
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, THOMAS B. ATTERBURY, of Pittsburg, county of Allegheny, State of Pennsylvania, have invented or discovered a new and useful Design for Glass Shades; and I do hereby declare the following to be a full, clear, concise, and exact description thereof, reference being had to the accompanying drawing making a part of this specification, in which—like letters indicating like parts—

Figure 1 shows my improved design with the addition of a fluted top and supporting-ring. Fig. 2 shows the design with supporting-ring, and Fig. 3 shows the same with the addition of a scalloped top.

My improved design for shades for illuminating-burners consists of a bulging globe, part *a* and tapering flutes *b* extending with a pyramidal slope from one end of the globe part *a*, so as to form the frustum of a hollow pyramid.

When this design is to be incorporated in

a shade for an ordinary lamp or gas-burner frame, a supporting-ring, *c*, is added to the smaller open end of the frustum, the upper open end of the globe part *a* being left plain, as in Fig. 2, or being made with an extended top, *d*, having the shape of the frustum of a hollow pyramid, as in Fig. 1, or having, as at *d'*, Fig. 3, a scalloped top; or, if the design set forth is to be used in a shade whose support is a spider-frame, the ring *c* may be omitted.

I claim herein—

The design of a shade for illuminating-burners, consisting of a bulging globe part, *a*, and tapering sloping flutes *b*, substantially as shown and described.
