

DESIGN FOR INKSTANDS.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8,868, dated December 28, 1875; application filed September 22, 1875.

[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Bloomfield Brower, of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented a Design for an Inkstand, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented

in the accompanying illustration.

In the illustration, A represents a curved sloping face, and the ornamental Egyptian device thereon, consisting of a lotus-flower with its stem resting on a ball, which is surrounded by two birds with spread wings; B B, the inwardly-curved pen-standards, and the ornamental Egyptian device thereon, consisting of star-points in half-circle, with spearends, feathered, diverging therefrom; CC, inwardly-curved sloping corners, and the Egyptian wing device thereon; D D, sloping faces, which may be dispensed with, if desired; E, ink-well, which may be of any desired shape; and F, the cover and the ornamental Egyptian device on top thereof, consisting of a circle of squares surrounding a ring with starpoints, and a star which has a ring and ball in its center.

The distinctive features of my invention are the configuration of the front of the base and the ornamental devices shown.

What I claim is-

1. The configuration of the base, consisting of the curved sloping face A, together with the inwardly-curved faces B B and the inwardly-curved sloping corners C C, substantially as specified and illustrated.

2. In a design for inkstands, the ornamental devices on the faces A, B, and C, arranged substantially as described and illustrated.

- 3. In a design for inkstands, the ornamental device on the face A, substantially as described and illustrated.
- 4. In a design for inkstands, the ornamental device on the pen-standard B, substantially as described and illustrated.
- 5. In a design for inkstands, the ornamental device on the corner C, substantially as described and illustrated.
- 6. In a design for inkstands, the ornamental device on the top of the cover F, substantially as specified and illustrated.
