

DESIGN FOR INKSTANDS.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,869**, dated December 28, 1875; application filed November 4, 1875 [Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, BLOOMFIELD BROWER, of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented a Design for an Inkstand, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying photographic illustration.

In the illustration, A represents the sloping face between the leaves B B and the ornamental device thereon, consisting of fancy leaves, banded near their lower ends, and diverging from the band; B B, ornamental leaves, sloping and diverging; C, sloping side back of the leaves B B and the ornamental devices thereon, consisting of a central rosette, with fancy carved indentations each side thereof. E represents the cover and the ornamental device on top thereof, consisting of leaflets surrounded by a circle of squares.

The configuration of the base and the ornamental devices A, B, C, and E are the distinctive features of my design, and are better shown in the illustration than I can describe them

What I claim is—

- 1. The configuration of the base, consisting of the sloping face A, together with the leaves B B and the sloping side C, substantially as specified and illustrated.
- 2. In an inkstand, the ornamental device on the sloping front A, substantially as described and illustrated.
- 3. In an inkstand, the ornamental leaves B, formed substantially as specified and illustrated.
- 4. In an inkstand, the ornamental device on the side C, substantially as described and illustrated.
- 5. In a design for inkstands, the ornamental device on top of the cover E, substantially as specified and illustrated.
