DESIGN FOR A FONT OF PRINTING-TYPES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,893**, dated January 11, 1876; application filed November 18, 1875.
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

CASE C.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JAMES M. CONNER, of Greenville, Hudson county, New Jersey, have invented and produced a new and original Design for a Font of Printing Types, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is clearly shown in the accompanying typographic impressions, to which reference is made.

The design shown is of the style known as "old-style," but the letters made in accordance with it are more condensed than in the old-style now made, and in some of the letters

the heavy line is extended above the top of the letter, in others below the bottom of the letter, and in the K, M, N, V, and W, this heavy line is extended below the hair-line and does not meet it, as is usual.

What I claim as new is—

The design for a font of printing-types, as shown.
