To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, HARRY H. DELACROIX, (assignor to MACKELLAR, SMITHS & JORDAN,) of the city and county of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented and produced a new and original Design for a Font of Printing-Types, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is clearly shown in the accompanying typographic impressions, to which reference is had; and consists of a

letter of the class known as Celtic, made heavier than such letters usually are, and having angular corners, as shown.
