



DESIGN FOR A CANISTER.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8,898, dated January 11, 1876; application filed November 24, 1875.

[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, SAMUEL ROSENBLATT, of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented a new and original Design for a Canister, of which the following is a specification:

In the accompanying drawing, Figure 1 is a side view, and Fig. 2 a top view, of my new design for a canister.

Similar letters of reference indicate corre-

sponding parts in both figures.

The nature of my design is fully represented in the figures, a and b being annuli at the top and bottom of the canister; B, the halves of the top; C, the center of the canister, and d the half of the top, having the projection f;

and e being the lid, which is of circular form, but divided by a straight line into two semicircular, or nearly semicircular, parts, d and e, as clearly shown in Fig. 2. An inclined pestle, f, projects from the part d on one side of the aforementioned straight dividing-line.

I claim as my invention-

The design for a canister contracted from both ends toward the center, having the annuli a and b at the ends, and the attachment f, all substantially as shown.
