

## DESIGN FOR BUTTONS.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8,906, dated January 18, 1876; application filed December 22, 1875. [Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Beit known that I, ISAAC LEHMANN, of the city, county, and State of New York, have originated and designed a new and ornamental Pattern or Design for Buttons, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompany. ing drawing, making part of this specifica-

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying drawing, to which reference is made.

A represents the body of the button, which is of dome shape on its face, and is surrounded by a fillet, B, at its base or back. The

dome-shaped face of the body A is ornamented by a figure representing a woven material, consisting of ropes a and bands b, interlacing one another at right angles, and giving to said surface a fancy check-like appearance. What I claim as my invention is—

A design for a button, in which the face of the body is of dome shape, and ornamented with representations of ropes and bands, interlacing each other at right angles, and surrounded by a fillet, substantially as specified. ISAAC LEHMANN.
