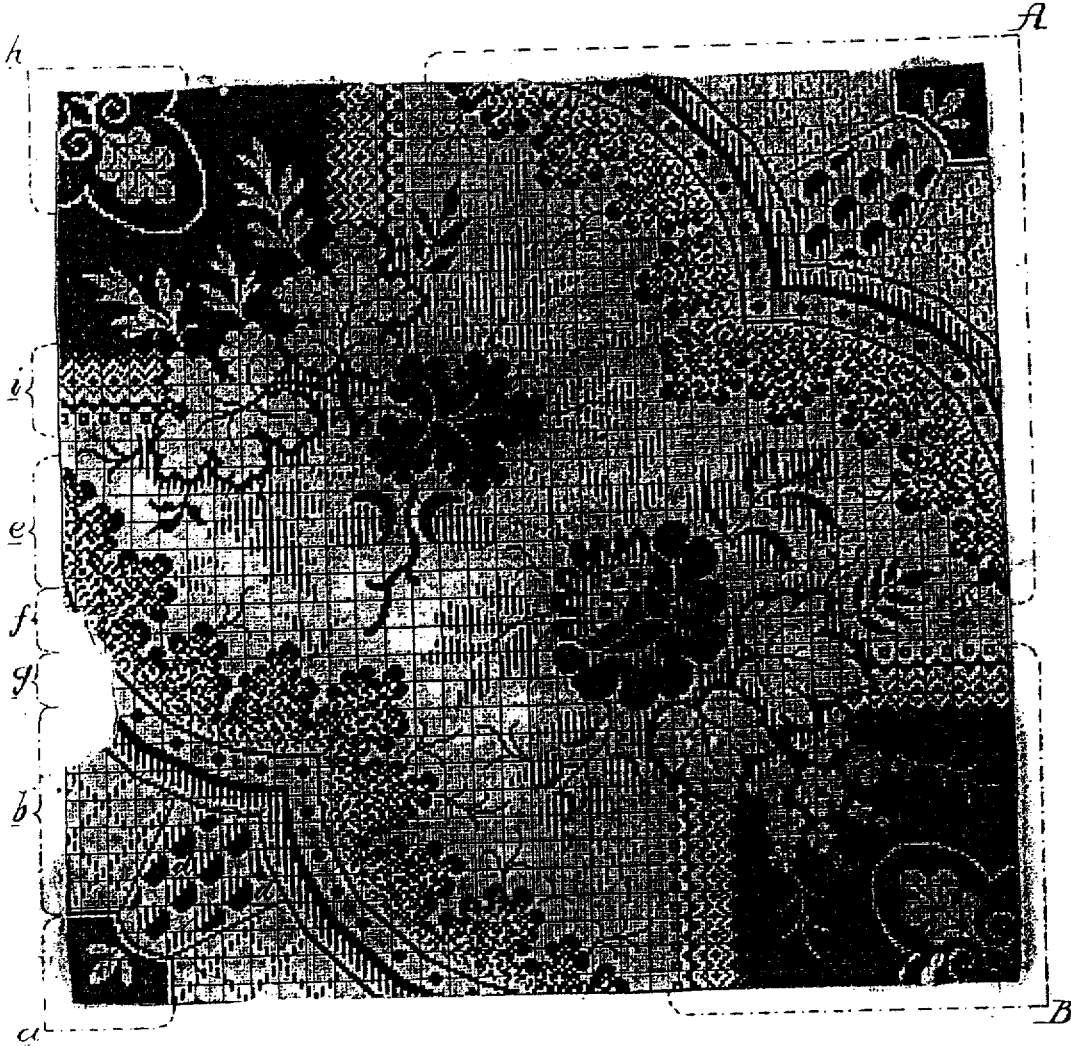

## DESIGN FOR CARPET.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8,918, dated January 18, 1876; application filed January 7, 1876  
[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, ALFRED HEALD, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented or produced a Design for a Carpet-Pattern, of which the following is a specification:

The accompanying photographic illustration represents sufficient of a carpet-pattern to show my design, which consists of two main figures, A and B.

The figure A comprises a central ornament, *a*, a groundwork, *b*, divided into squares by lines, and crossed by figures *d*, ornamented by shaded spots, and extending from the central ornament to the border, which consists of three curved bands, the outer one, *e*, of a foliated character, the central one, *f*, provided with spots, arranged at regular intervals, and the inner one, *g*, composed of lines.

The figure B has a central ornament, *h*, and a zigzag and spotted border, *i*, and each corner of this figure is provided with foliated or-

namentation, consisting of stems, leaves, and flowers, of a character too clearly shown to need description.

Irrespective of the colors employed, I claim—

1. The design for the figure A, comprising the ornament *a*, groundwork *b*, figures *d*, and border composed of curved bands *e*, *f*, and *g*, as shown and described.

2. The design for the figures B, comprising the central ornaments *h*, borders *i*, and foliated corner ornamentation, as shown and described.

3. The design for the whole pattern, including the figures A and B.
