## DESIGN FOR PORTABLE GRATE.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8,920, dated January 18, 1876; application filed January 13, 1876, [Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, FRANK A. MAGEE, of Chelsea, in the county of Suffolk and State of Massachusetts, have invented and produced a new and original Design for a Portable Grate, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying photograph, making part of this specification.

In the photograph, A represents the baseplate of the grate, which is supported on ornamental legs a. B is the body, and C a portion projecting in front thereof to receive the ash-pan. Above this portion C is the hearth b, provided with a fender-rail, c, extending between the posts d. On each side of the body B is a raised ornamental panel, w, and on each end of the portion C is a raised panel, e, having a center ornament, f, the front corners of the portion C, which are beveled as shown, being each ornamented with a pillar, g. The front of the grate has on each side of the fire-place an ornamental pillar, h, and the top of the fire-place, above the hood i, is made in the form shown, with a straight central portion, 5, and two curved corner portions, 6 6, above each of which is a panel, k, having an ornamental scroll. Above the center of the top of the fire-place is an ornament, l, resembling the key-stone of an arch, having on each side a row of ornamental projections, m, above which is a chain ornament, n. The

front of the fire-place is provided with horizontal bars o, which are intersected by vertical bars p, forming panels, the top of each of the bars p being surmounted by an acorn-shaped tip. The top D of the grate is of the form shown, with projecting points 7 near its front corners, and on this top rests the base of an ornamental urn, E, having two handles, q, on opposite sides. G is the blower, of the form shown, having two panels, r, one on each side of the handle s, a rosette, t, being placed between the two panels r, the bottom of the blower being provided with a series of small panels, s. The ash-pit door H is provided with an ornamental panel, having a rosette, s, at each side, the two upper corners of the door being rounded.

What I claim as my invention, and desire

to secure by Letters Patent, is—

1. The design for a portable grate, substantially as herein shown and described.

2. The design of the urn E, as shown and described.

3. The design of the blower G, as shown and described.
