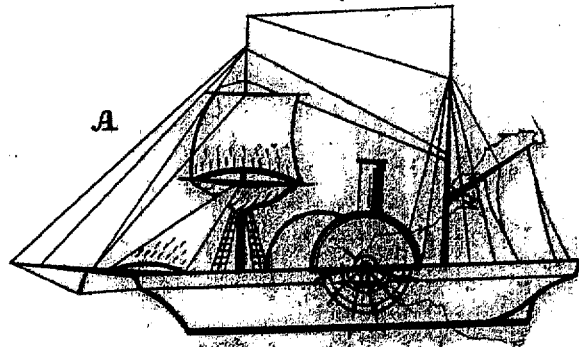

## DESIGN FOR TOY BALLOON.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,992**, dated February 8, 1876; application filed December 29, 1875.  
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, HUGH S. KERR, of the city and county of Philadelphia and State of Pennsylvania, have originated and designed a new and useful Design for Toy Balloon, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, making part of this specification.

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying drawing, to which reference is made.

My invention consists of a design for a toy balloon of the form of a ship, A, thus producing an amusing and attractive toy.
