DESIGN FOR BACK COMB.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8.997, dated February 15, 1876; application filed January 27, 1876.

[Term of Patent 31 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JULIUS W. FLEISCH-MANN, of Williamsburg, in the county of Kings and State of New York, have invented certain new and useful Improvements in Design for Combs; and I do hereby declare that the following is a full, clear, and exact description thereof, which will enable others skilled in the art to which it appertains to make and use-the same, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, and to the letters of reference marked thereon, which form a part of this specification.

My design relates to back combs, and is fully illustrated in the accompanying drawing. It consists in one or more frames, formed at the top of the comb, with glass or porcelain pictures inserted in said frames, as will be hereinafter more fully set forth.

In the annexed drawing, A represents an ordinary back comb made of tortoise-shell or other suitable material. The top of this comb is formed with one or more frames, B, in which are fastened pictures C, made either of glass or porcelain.

What I claim is-

The design for back comb, composed, essentially, of the comb proper A, ornamental head-piece B, and picture cases C C, substantially as shown in the accompanying illustration.
