

## **DESIGN FOR A VASE.**

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,006, dated February 15, 1876; application filed January 31, 1876.

[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, MELVILLE D. JONES, of Boston, Suffolk county, Massachusetts, have invented a Design for Bowl of Vase, of which the following is a specification:

In general form the design of this bowl is composed of two prominent portions, the upper, a, of which is annular, and is semi-prolate spheroidal in form, with a narrow border or rim, b, while the lower portion, c, which is surmounted by this annular portion, and is of much less diameter, is substantially in the form of an inverted truncated cone, whose sides are ogee curves. The bottom of the bowl  $a \ b \ c$  of this vase terminates at the dotted line

1; and I have shown at d, in the accompanying illustration, a pedestal, upon which such bowl is mounted; but this base constitutes no portion of my present design, which is embraced, essentially, in the two portions a c.

I claim—

The design for a vase, composed, essentially, of the portions *a c*, substantially as described, and as shown in the accompanying illustration.
