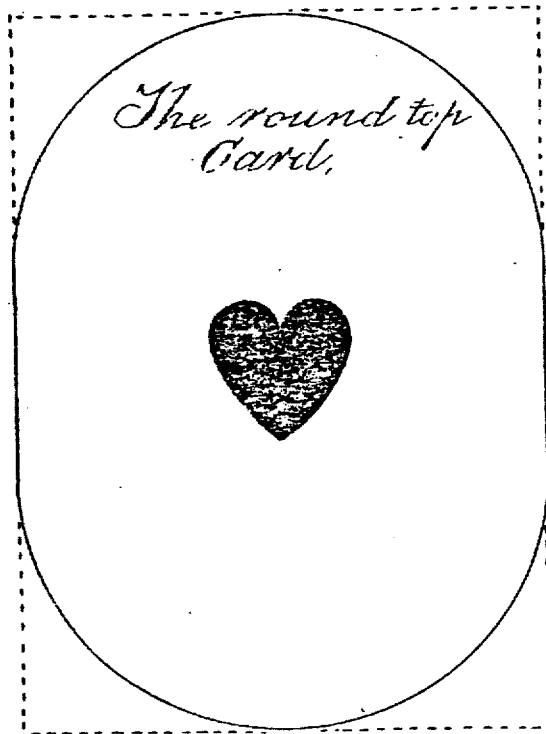

DESIGN FOR PLAYING-CARDS.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,011**, dated February 22, 1876; application filed February 7, 1876.
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern :

Be it known that I, JAMES DUTHIE, of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented and produced a new and original Design for Playing-Cards, of which the following is a specification :

The nature of my invention is fully shown in the accompanying drawing, to which reference is made; and consists of what I term as "The Round-Top Card," the ends or top and bottom of the card being each in the form of a semicircle, the sides being straight and parallel with each other.

What I claim as my invention, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design for a playing-card, the top and the bottom or ends of the card being semicircular in form, and the sides straight and parallel, as herein described, and shown in the accompanying drawing.
