

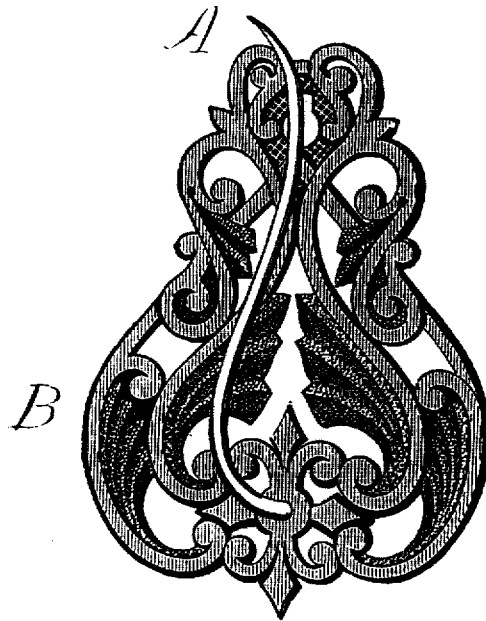

DESIGN FOR PAPER-CLIPS.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,120**, dated March 7, 1876; application filed February 16, 1876.
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern :

Be it known that I, OTTO F. FOGELSTRAND, of Kensington, in the county of Hartford and State of Connecticut, have invented and produced a new and original design for a Paper-File, of which the following is a specification :

The nature of my design is fully represented by the accompanying engraving, to which reference is made.

A represents the usual hook, and B the base, composed mainly of curved bars, interlocking each other, as shown. At the widest portion of this base the two outer curved bars are parallel. Between the lower ends of these parallel scroll-bars there are four smaller curves and four diamond-shaped figures, sur-

rounding a disk-shaped center, from which the hook A extends. The front surface of all of said parts is plain and smooth. Upon the inside of the parallel curved bars, near their base, parts of leaflets are formed, having a roughened surface, and a little back from the surface of the other parts.

I claim as my invention—

The design for a paper-file in which the base is composed of curved bars ornamented with partial leaflets, substantially in the manner shown and described.
