

DESIGN FOR INKSTANDS.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9.143, dated March 14, 1876; application filed February 16, 1876. [Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, OTTO F. FOGELSTRAND, of Kensington, in the county of Hartford and State of Connecticut, have invented and produced a new and original Design for an Inkstand, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying drawing, to which reference is made.

A represents the base, which is saucer-shaped, and has a scalloped edge. The interior of said saucer has a groundwork of finely-checked lines, and is ornamented with leaflets, as shown. B represents the body of the inkstand, which has flaring sides, ornamented by a plain band at the base, a scalloped band at the top, between which bands there are alternate round-top and ogee-sided elevations on fluted ground, as shown. The cover C is

ornamented by a rosette in the center, with leaflets radiating therefrom.

I claim as my invention-

1. The design for the body of the inkstand, ornamented by the bands, elevations, and fluted ground, as shown and described.

2. The design for the base A, consisting of the scalloped edge saucer, ornamented by

leaflets, as shown and described.

3. The design for an inkstand, consisting of the saucer-shaped base A, having the scalloped-edge body B, ornamented by bands, elevations, and fluted ground, and cover C, ornamented by radial leaflets and central rosette, all substantially as shown and described.
