

DESIGN FOR CARRIAGE-SEAT BACKS.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,146, dated March 21, 1876; application filed December 18, 1875.

[Term of Patent 14 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, DAVID BUCKLER, of Listowell, in the Province of Ontario and Dominion of Canada, have invented a new and original Design for Carriage-Seat Back, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying photographic illustra-

tion, to which reference is made.

The said design consists of a seat-back with a bulged middle division, separating it in two parts, right and left, which parts are of concave form from the division to the sides of the body, and from the division the two parts are each arched on the top to the sides.

I claim as my invention-

The seat-back of a carriage equally divided by a median bulge into two concaved and toparched portions, as shown and described, to form a new design.
