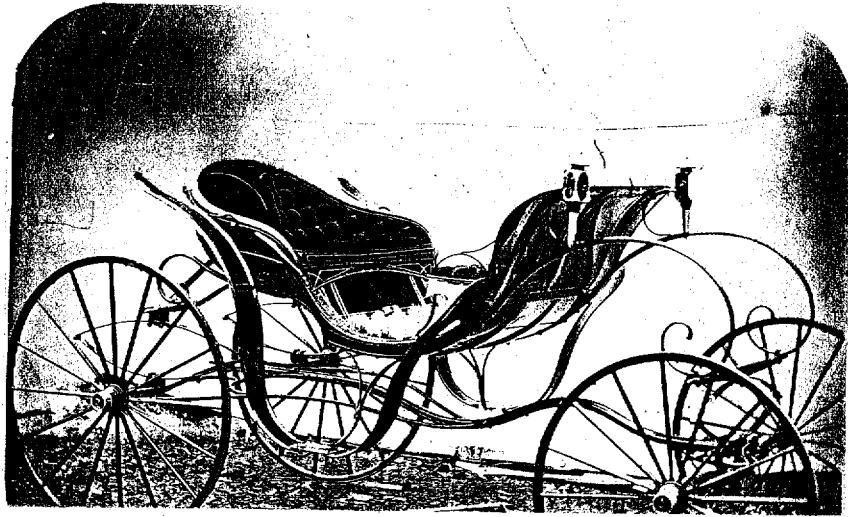

DESIGN FOR CARRIAGE-SEAT BACKS.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,146**, dated March 21, 1876; application filed December 18, 1875.
[Term of Patent 14 years.]

To all whom it may concern :

Be it known that I, DAVID BUCKLER, of Listowell, in the Province of Ontario and Dominion of Canada, have invented a new and original Design for Carriage-Seat Back, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying photographic illustration, to which reference is made.

The said design consists of a seat-back with a bulged middle division, separating it in two parts, right and left, which parts are of con-

cave form from the division to the sides of the body, and from the division the two parts are each arched on the top to the sides.

I claim as my invention—

The seat-back of a carriage equally divided by a median bulge into two concaved and top-arched portions, as shown and described, to form a new design.
