

DESIGN FOR A TOY CARRIAGE.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,149, dated March 21, 1876; application filed April 10, 1875. [Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, FREDERICK W. Por-TER, of Springfield, in the State of Vermont, have invented a Design for Toy Carriages, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented

in the accompanying photographic illustra-tion, to which reference is made.

A represents the body of the carriage; B B', the wheels; C, the canopy; D, its support, and E the pushing handle.

I am aware that carriages with three wheels and with a canopy have heretofore been made,

and I do not claim the design of the same; neither do I claim the mechanical construction; but

What I do claim as my invention is-

The design for a toy carriage formed of the parts A B B' C D E, grouped together substantially as herein described, and shown in the accompanying illustration.
