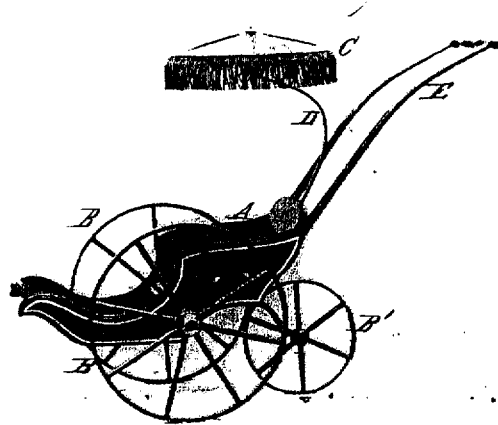

## DESIGN FOR A TOY CARRIAGE.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,149**, dated March 21, 1876; application filed April 10, 1875.  
[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

*To all whom it may concern :*

Be it known that I, FREDERICK W. PORTER, of Springfield, in the State of Vermont, have invented a Design for Toy Carriages, of which the following is a specification :

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying photographic illustration, to which reference is made.

A represents the body of the carriage; B B', the wheels; C, the canopy; D, its support, and E the pushing-handle.

I am aware that carriages with three wheels and with a canopy have heretofore been made,

and I do not claim the design of the same; neither do I claim the mechanical construction; but

What I do claim as my invention is—

The design for a toy carriage formed of the parts A B B' C D E, grouped together substantially as herein described, and shown in the accompanying illustration.
