DESIGN FOR HEATING-STOVE.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,166, dated March 28, 1876; application filed March 19, 1874.

[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, CONRAD HARRIS and EDWARD KUMMER, both of Cincinnati, in the county of Hamilton and State of Ohio, have invented a new and useful Design for a Wood Heating Stove, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying photographic illustration, making part of this specification.

The nature of our design is fully represented in the accompanying photographic illustra-

tion, to which reference is made.

The body of the stove is a shell, oval or elliptical in cross-section, and arranged horizontally. Its heads, back, and front carry on top an ornament, A, of scroll-work, and are pro-

vided with a bevel-molding, B. The front head of the stove is provided with a door, upon which is formed a shield-like ornament, C. The rear head is formed like the front head; but a panel is substituted for the door. The base D, upon which the urn rests, has upon each side an ornament, E.

What we claim as our invention is—

The herein-described design for a wood heating-stove, ornamented as at A, B, C, and E, substantially as illustrated.
