DESIGN FOR A FONT OF PRINTING-TYPES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,167**, dated March 28, 1876; application filed February 28, 1876.
[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JOHN K. ROGERS, of Brookline, county of Norfolk and State of Massachusetts, have invented a Design for Printing-Types, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying impression from the types, to which reference is made.

The face of this design, which consists of capitals, points, figures, and "lower-case" let-

ters, resembles, and is similar to, the style known as "black letter," but is of a wide and bold character, making it especially adaptable to lines which require extension; and

The design for a font of printing-types, as shown and described.
