## DESIGN FOR DECORATIVE SHIELDS.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,169**, dated March 28, 1876; application filed February 16, 1876.  
[Term of Patent 35 years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, ANTON WEIDMANN, of the city, county, and State of New York, have originated and designed a Shield for Decoration, of which the following is a clear, exact, and full description, reference being had to the accompanying illustration, making a part of this specification.

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying painted illustration, to which reference is made.

My design consists of the American shield, having transversely in the "field of stars," at the upper part of the shield, and in the red and

white stripes in the lower part of the same, or in either place, a blank scroll, ribbon, or space for the reception of a motto.

What I claim as my invention is—

The design for a decorative shield, consisting of the American shield having transverse scrolls, ribbons, or spaces in the field of stars, and in the stripes, or in either position, substantially as shown and described.
