## DESIGN FOR A FONT OF PRINTING-TYPES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,184**, dated April 4, 1876; application filed March 27, 1876.  
[Term of Patent 14 years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, HENRY BREHMER, of Stapleton, county of Richmond and State of New York, have originated and designed a new Design for a Font of Printing-Types, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is clearly shown in the accompanying typographic impression, to which reference is made; and consists of lower-case, capitals, points, and figures, similar to the Roman, but with the capital and base of the character or letter, compared with the other lines, very heavy, and forked or split at the ceriph and corresponding parts into a double crescent-shaped head and base, the

outer points of which turn or flow upward from the bottom and downward from the top to the right and left of the main or body line.

The letter is shaded on the right side and bottom by a shade-line of uniform weight or thickness, following the shape of the body.

What I claim as my invention, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design or pattern for a font of printing-types, as shown and described.
