

## DESIGN FOR CARPETS.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,192, dated April 4, 1876; application filed March 27, 1876.

[Term of Patent 3; years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ALFRED HEALD, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have produced or invented a Design for a Carpet Pattern, of which the following is a specification:

My design for a carpet pattern is fully shown in the accompanying photographic illustration.

The design is of a foliated character throughout, its main features being the two groups, a and b, each comprising flowers, blossoms, leaves, and stems. The intervening space or groundwork of the pattern is ornamented with flowers d and stems e, in a manner which

is too clearly shown to need minute description.

Irrespective of the colors employed, I claim—

The design for a carpet-pattern, substantially as described, and as shown in and by the accompanying drawing.
