DESIGN FOR CARPETS.

To all whom it may concern:

The design is of a foliated character throughout, and its main features are the groups of flowers a, b, c, and d, and leaves c, f, g, and h, the intervening spaces or groundwork of the fabric being ornamented with leaves and stems, of a character too clearly shown to need description.
