DESIGN FOR A FONT OF PRINTING-TYPES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,195**, dated April 4, 1876; application filed March 20, 1876.
[Term of Patent 14 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JULIUS HERRIET, of the city and county of New York, and State of New York, have originated and designed a new Design for a Font of Printing-Types, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is clearly shown in the accompanying typographic impression, to which reference is made; and consists of Old English or Black lower-case, capitals, figures, and points, skeltoned, with latitudinal lines run into the face, which has a diagonal black shade on the right side and other portions, to aid the perspective, and a diagonal ray-shade attached to said black shade.

The whole design is similar in character and supplementary to the design in Roman type for which Letters Patent No. 7,993, dated January 12, 1875, were granted to David Wolfe Bruce, of New York, the assignee of the present design.

What I claim as my invention, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design or pattern for a font of printing-types, as shown and described.
