



DESIGN FOR BEER-MUG.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,199, dated April 4, 1876; application filed February 29, 1876.

[Term of Patent 3; years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILLIAM C. King, of Pittsburg, county of Allegheny, State of Pennsylvania, have invented or discovered a new and useful Design for Beer-Mugs; and I do bereby declare the following to be a full, clear, concise, and exact description thereof, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, making a part of this specification, in which, like letters indicating like parts—

Figure 1 is a side elevation of the mug, and Fig. 2 is a sectional view in the line xx, Fig. 1.

My improved design for beer mugs consists of vertical flutings x on the outer periphery of

My improved design for beer mugs consists of vertical flutings a on the outer periphery of the mug made convex in cross-section. These

flutings extend up the sides of the mug to a point a little below the upper end, where they terminate in a plain or smoothly-finished mouth, c. The beer mug handle is represented at d.

I claim-

The design for beer-mugs, of convex flutes a, smooth month c, and handle d, substantially as shown and described.
