## DESIGN FOR BEER-MUGS.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,204, dated April 11, 1876; application filed March 30, 1876.

[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, GEORGE B. FOWLE, of Boston, county of Suffolk, State of Massachusetts, have invented or discovered a new and useful Design for Beer-Mugs; and I do hereby declare the following to be a full, clear, concise, and exact description thereof, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, making a part of this specification, which shows, in elevation or side view, a beer-mug having my improved design.

This design consists of a band of stars around the barrel of the glass mug, at or not far from a point midway between its ends,

with vertical flutings above and below. The stars are represented at a and the flutings at b.

I claim as my improved design for beer-mugs—

A band of stars around the barrel of the mug, with flutings above and below, substantially as described and shown.
