


## DESIGN FOR BOTTLE.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,207, dated April 11, 1876; application filed March 29, 1876. [Term of Patent 31 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ROBERT P. SMITH, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented a Design for a Bottle, of which the following is a specification:

My design for a bottle is fully shown in the accompanying drawing, in which Figure 1 is a front view, and Fig. 2 an end view, of the

The body A is made in the form of a building, and has a central dome, B, forming the neck of the bottle, and surmounted by the cap or cover D.

The building has a central projecting portion, a, with doors b, and has, at each corner, towers d, with windows. The portions e, be-

tween the central projection a and towers d, have windows f. The ends g of the body have windows h.

I claim-

The design for a bottle, the body A of which is made in the form of a building, and has a dome, B, forming the neck of the bottle, substantially as shown and described.
