

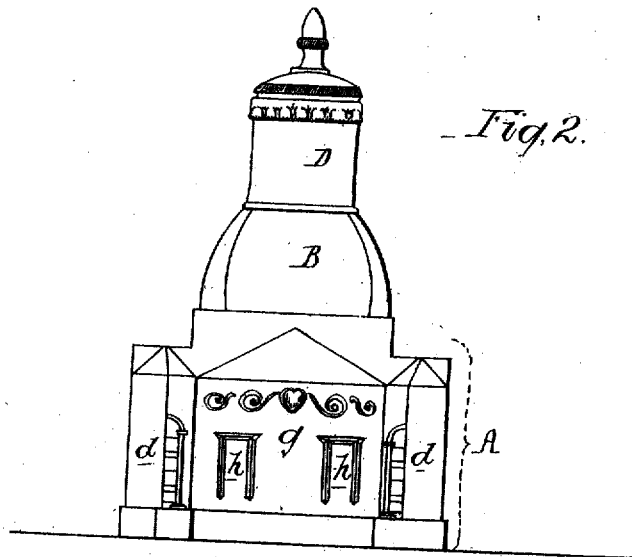
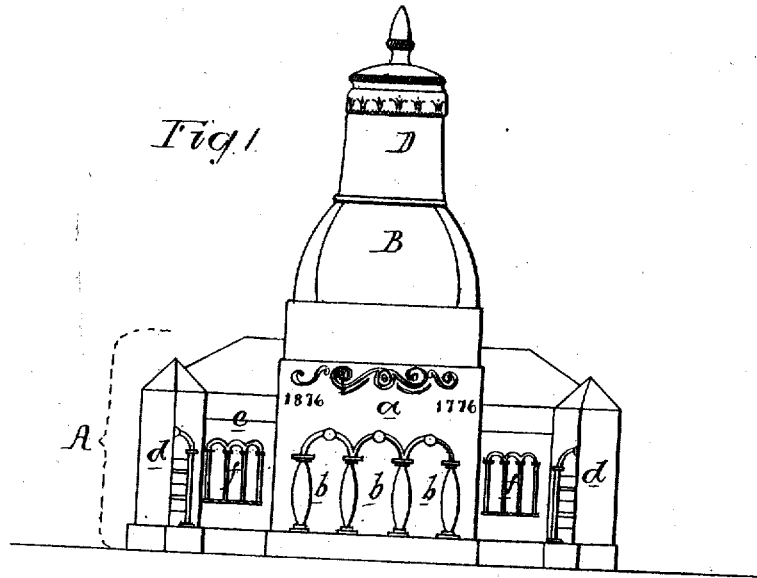

DESIGN FOR BOTTLE.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,207**, dated April 11, 1876; application filed March 29, 1876.
[Term of Patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.]

To all whom it may concern :

Be it known that I, ROBERT P. SMITH, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented a Design for a Bottle, of which the following is a specification :

My design for a bottle is fully shown in the accompanying drawing, in which Figure 1 is a front view, and Fig. 2 an end view, of the bottle.

The body A is made in the form of a building, and has a central dome, B, forming the neck of the bottle, and surmounted by the cap or cover D.

The building has a central projecting portion, *a*, with doors *b*, and has, at each corner, towers *d*, with windows. The portions *e*, be-

tween the central projection *a* and towers *d*, have windows *f*. The ends *g* of the body have windows *h*.

I claim—

The design for a bottle, the body A of which is made in the form of a building, and has a dome, B, forming the neck of the bottle, substantially as shown and described.
