




DESIGN FOR TRAYS.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,209, dated April 11, 1876; application filed March 11, 1876.

[Term of Patent 14 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, DANIEL M. CUMMINGS, of Enfield, county of Grafton, State of New Hampshire, have originated a Design for a Tray, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, in which—

Figure 1 is a side elevation of the tray, Fig. 2 an end elevation, and Fig. 3 an inverted

plan view.

The tray is oblong in form, with rounded corners, the length being nearly double the width, and the height of the body A being about one-third the width. At the bottom of the tray is a base or projection, a, the length of which is about one-fourth less than that of the body, and the width a little more than a is the length. The sides a of the body are curved or rounded from the upper edge a

to the projection a, and the edges s of the latter are curved inwardly or grooved from the bottom to their junction with the edges x. The interior of the tray is of any suitable shape.

Without confining myself to the exact pro-

portions specified, I claim-

A design for a tray, oblong in form, with rounded corners and rounded sides x, and having at the bottom a projection, a, with inwardly curved edges s, substantially as set forth.
