

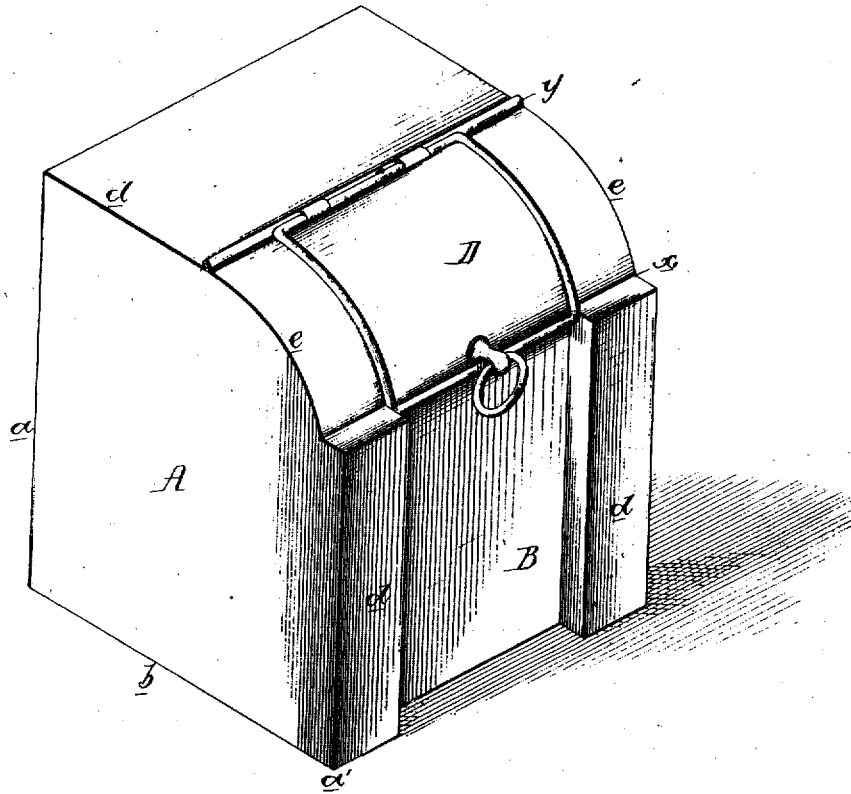

DESIGN FOR CANISTERS.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,235**, dated April 18, 1876; application filed March 10, 1876.
[Term of Patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.]

To all whom it may concern :

Be it known that I, JOSEPH B. ROHRMAN, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have originated and designed a new Canister for Containing Coffee, Tea, &c., of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, which represents the canister in perspective.

Each of the opposite sides A of the canister is bounded by the vertical edges $a a'$, the base b and straight top d , and the curved edge e , which also represents the contour of the cover D when the latter is closed, as shown in the drawing. The front, B, of the canister has two projecting rectangular pilasters, $d d'$, arranged as shown, the pilasters extending from the base to the line x , whence the rounded edges e extend to the front edge y of the flat top of the canister.

I claim—

1. The front B of the canister, having projecting rectangular pilasters $d d'$, as shown and described.
2. The canister having vertical sides and back, rounded lid, and vertical front, with projecting rectangular pilasters, substantially as described, and as shown in and by the accompanying drawing.
