

DESIGN FOR A COOKING-STOVE.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,236, dated April 25, 1876; application filed April 15, 1876. [Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, EDWARD CALLELY, of the city of Philadelphia, State of Pennsylvania, have invented or produced a Design for a Cooking Range or Stove, of which the following is a specification:

My design is for a cooking range or stove, and is fully set forth and shown in the accompanying photographic illustration, to which

reference is made.

A represents the top; B, the front; C, the end or side; D, the base; E E', the ovendoors; F, the charging-door; G, the ash-pit door; H H', openings for pipe to water-back;

I, draft-slide; J J' J", registers to the oven and ash-pit doors.

What I claim as my invention is—

A design for a cooking range or stove, substantially as described, and as illustrated in and by the accompanying drawings.
