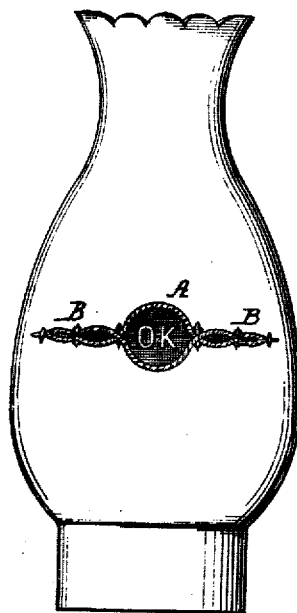

DESIGN FOR LAMP-CHIMNEYS.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,246**, dated April 25, 1876; application filed November 1, 1875.
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JOHN SCHMITT, of Pittsburg, in the county of Allegheny and State of Pennsylvania, have originated a Design for Lamp-Chimneys, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, making part of this specification.

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying drawing, to which reference is made.

A represents a circular shield in dark ground or other color necessary for the bringing out in relief of the formation of said shield, and of the letters which may be arranged thereon,

such as "O. K.," (shown in the drawing,) said shield having radiating arms B of a similar shade or color as the shield, ornamented in the style as shown.

What I claim as my invention is—

A design for lamp-chimneys composed of the round shield A, having the radiating arms B B, said shield and arms being of a color sufficient to bring them out in relief from the chimney, substantially as described.
