

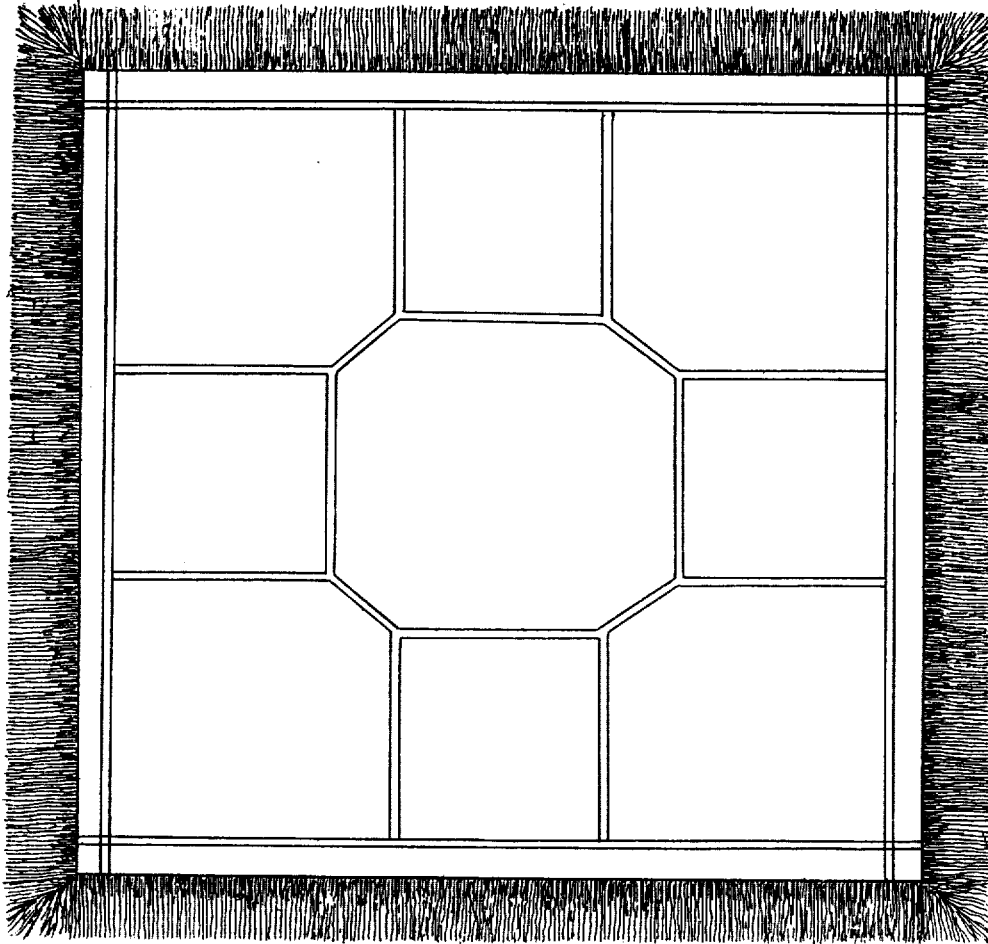

DESIGN FOR AN ADVERTISING TABLE-NAPKIN.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,261, dated May 2, 1876; application filed April 7, 1876.
[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ENOS G. TORBERT, of Philadelphia, in the county of Philadelphia and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a certain new and useful Design for Table-Napkins; and I do hereby declare the following to be a full, clear, and exact description of the invention, such as will enable others skilled in the art to which it pertains to make and use it, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, which form part of this specification.

My invention has relation to table-napkins used as mediums for advertising; and consists in a plan or design of ornamenting, pressing, or imprinting the surfaces of such napkins, so as to present a novel configuration and shape of the spaces designed for the reception of such advertisements.

Referring to the accompanying drawing, A

represents an ordinary table-napkin, divided by lines *a* into spaces for the reception of various advertisements, which are to be printed or otherwise delineated thereon. These lines are so drawn as to form the following spaces, viz: The octagon center B, rectangular parallelograms C C, and corner polygons D D.

What I claim as my invention is—

The design for an advertising table-napkin, substantially as herein described, and shown in the accompanying drawing.
