DESIGN FOR CARPETS.

Specification forming part of Design No. **9,267**, dated May 2, 1876; application filed April 20, 1876.
[Term of Patent $3\frac{1}{4}$ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JOHN HAMER, a citizen of Great Britain, residing in the county of Dutchess and State of New York, have invented and produced a new and original Design for a Pattern to be Printed on Druggets, Felts, or other fabrics used for carpeting, or to be inwrought in such colors as may be desired; and I do hereby declare that the photographic print accompanying this specification does give and convey to any one skilled in the art of carpet-printing a more definite and thorough description of the nature of my invention than it is in the power of language to convey, and it is sufficient to enable any

one skilled in the art of carpet-printing to use my invention.

What I claim as my invention, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The configuration of the design hereunto annexed, the same being adapted to be printed on druggets, felts, or other fabrics used for carpeting, or inwrought in the form similar to the photographic print accompanying this specification.
