

DESIGN FOR MANUFACTURED TOBACCO.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,268, dated May 2, 1876; application filed March 20, 1876. [Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WITCHER JONES, of Danville, in the county of Pittsylvania and State of Virginia, have invented certain new and useful improvements in Designs for Manufactured Tobacco; and I do hereby declare that the following is a full, clear, and exact description thereof, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, and to the letters of reference marked thereon, which form part of this specification.

The nature of my design is fully illustrated in the accompanying drawing; and it consists in manufactured plug-tobacco twisted in the form shown.

A represents a plug of manufactured tobacco which is made in the form of a sailor's knot, as is fully indicated in the drawing.

What I claim is—

The design for manufactured plug-tobacco, consisting of a sailor's knot, as shown and described.
