DESIGN FOR ORNAMENTAL SKIRT-BORDERS.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,302, dated May 23, 1876; application filed April 11, 1876.

[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all when it may concern:

Be it known that I, ISIDOR HAUSER, of city and State of New York, have invented an original Design for Ornamental Skirt-Borders, of which the following is a specification:

This design, imprinted or otherwise formed on skirt-borders, consists, as shown in the drawing, of a row of stars, each surrounded by a circle of smaller stars. Each circle, in turn, is surrounded by a circle of arabesque work. The distance between these medallions is sufficient to give room for a sinuous stripe, which passes alternately over and under the medallions, and is provided with arabesque borders. Upon the stripe appear, in continuous succession, the words and figures "1776, Centennial, 1876, Centennial," &c. Above the row of medallions is a horizontal stripe orna-

mented with stars. Between this stripe and the medallions are vertical bars, alternately of different colors.

The details of the design will be gathered by reference to the accompanying drawing, which represents a portion of the border.

Various colors, at will, may be used for the different members of the design.

I claim-

The design for ornamental skirt-borders, as shown and described.
