

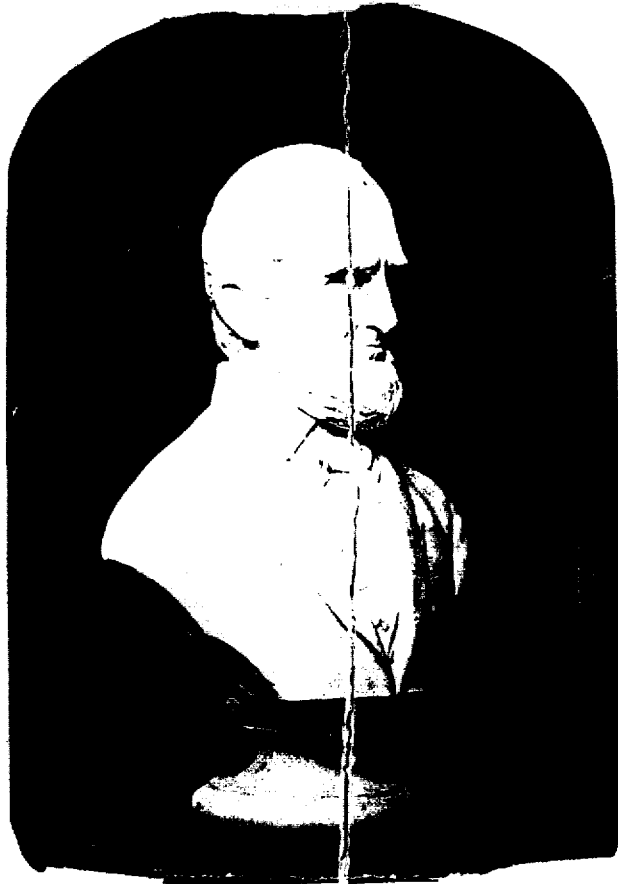

DESIGN FOR A BUST.

Specification forming part of Design No. 9,338, dated June 13, 1876; application filed May 10, 1876.
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, DAVID M. FRENCH, of the town of Newburyport, county of Essex, and State of Massachusetts, have designed, invented, and produced a new sculptured figure, representing the bust of John G. Whittier.

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying photographic illustration, to which reference is made.

The bust is modeled from life, and may be constructed of plaster, marble, bronze, or any other suitable material, and of such size as may be desired, care being taken to preserve the just proportion of the different parts,

Having thus described my invention, I claim as new and desire to secure by Letters Patent—

The design for a bust, substantially as described, and shown in the accompanying illustration.
